Objective

The key objective of the Library was to provide somewhere for community enrichment in the Docklands. Up until now, construction has focussed on apartments and commercial buildings, but nothing for the community. Library at the Dock was designed to create some cohesion for the diverse backgrounds of the people who live in Docklands.

The Solution

The Library at The Dock, a pioneering example of sustainable architecture, required an equally innovative approach to window coverings. To complement its environmentally conscious design, Vertilux custom manufactured 34 Motorised Cedar Venetian Blinds.

These Blinds seamlessly blended in with the building’s natural aesthetic while providing precise light control in maintaining the building’s passive ventilation strategy.
